USE OF CHANGING FACILITIES POLICY

POLICY ON THE USE OF CHANGING ROOMS

The Club strives to ensure that all juniors (anyone under 18) are safeguarded from abuse and have an enjoyable sporting experience.

This policy applies to all Members, staff, coaches, players, parents/carers and any other individuals associated with the Club.

This document sets out the Club's policy for the acceptable use of our changing rooms.

1. Juniors U12 are encouraged to arrive for Sport already changed, and dressed appropriate for the time of year.
2. Juniors U12 may only use the same sex Gentleman's or Ladies' Dressing Rooms if accompanied by an adult Member who is the parent or grandparent or guardian or adult acting with the prior consent of the parent or guardian.
3. Juniors 12 years or older using the Club facilities, including the changing rooms, and courts are subject to the same rules, discipline and behaviour expectations as adult Members.
4. It is advised, where a coach or volunteer is delivering the activity or session to the juniors, they should avoid using the changing rooms or showering at the same time as those juniors.
5. If we are made aware that a junior or adult self-identifies as a gender that differs from the gender they were assigned at birth, we will work with them and their parents/carers (where it relates to a junior) to make reasonable adjustments to changing arrangements to suit their needs *{for more information on this please go to <https://thecpsu.org.uk>}*
6. Mobile phones and other electronic devices may only be used in changing rooms provided that calls are discreet and kept short.
7. For younger groups of juniors, a DBS checked member of staff or volunteer will wait outside the changing rooms to allow juniors to call for assistance if required.
8. Where no changing facilities are available juniors, parents and travelling teams/players will be made aware prior to the game and advised to make alternative arrangements and to take appropriate additional clothing e.g, tracksuits etc.
